

# A 200m fiber optic connection can be used with a 100Mbps router

- **Ethernet Switches:** Place a switch at the 100-meter mark to regenerate the signal. This effectively splits the 200-meter run into two 100-meter segments .
- **Fiber-to-Ethernet Media Converters:** Convert the fiber signal to Ethernet at the ONT, then use a second converter near the router to maintain signal integrity over long d...
