Role in the Access Layer

In a hierarchical network, the access layer is the first point of connection for end devices such as computers, IP phones, printers, and wireless access points. L2 switches at this layer provide port density, network reliability, and security control, ensuring stable connectivity and enforcing VLAN segmentation and security policies. They often support Power over Ethernet (PoE) for devices like IP phones and cameras, and maintain bandwidth for daily operations .

- **MAC Address Forwarding:** L2 switches learn MAC addresses from incoming frames and forward packets only to the correct destination port within the same VLAN .
- **VLAN Support:** They allow network segmentation, creating multiple broadcast domains to improve traffic management and security .
- **Spanning Tree Protocol (STP):** Prevents loops in the network topology.
- **Link Aggregation and Port Mirroring:** Enhances bandwidth and monitoring capabilities.
- **Security Features:** Advanced L2 switches can implement ACLs, 802.1X authentication, RADIUS, and DHCP snooping to protect against unauthorized access
