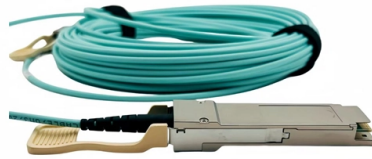


Are routers and fiber optic cables the same thing

A router is indirectly connected to fiber optic cables through an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which converts light signals from the fiber into electrical signals the router can use.

How Fiber Optic Internet Works

Fiber optic cables transmit data as light signals, which travel at high speeds and are immune to interference, unlike traditional copper cables. However, standard routers cannot directly interpret these light signals. Instead, the fiber line terminates at an Optical Network Terminal (ONT), usually installed by your Internet Service Provider (ISP). The ONT converts the incoming light signals into electrical signals compatible with routers and other network devices.

Connecting a Router to Fiber

Once the ONT converts the signal, it outputs data through a standard Ethernet port, which is then connected to your router's WAN or Internet port using an Ethernet cable. This allows the router to distribute the internet connection to your devices via wired or wireless connections. While any modern router can work with fiber internet, fiber-optimized routers can better handle high speeds and maximize the performance of the fiber connection.
