Bolt Types and Materials

Bus connector bolts are typically M5, M6, or M8 depending on busbar thickness, current rating, and mechanical requirements . Common materials include:

Washers and Vibration Mitigation

Proper washer selection is essential to maintain clamping force and prevent loosening:

- Flat washers: used on both sides of the bolt to protect busbar surfaces .
- Belleville washers: recommended in applications with vibration or thermal expansion to maintain consistent clamping force over time .
- Only one Belleville washer per bolt is typically used, with flat washers beneath to prevent surface indentation
