

Cable Requirements for Heating Equipment Distribution Box

3. **Grounding and Safety** Proper grounding is essential. All cables entering the distribution box should be connected to a grounding bus or terminal. Include overcurrent protection devices such as circuit breakers or fuses for each circuit to prevent short circuits and overloads ().

4. **Cable Routing and Management** Maintain neat cable management inside the distribution box. Use cable entry points, DIN rails, and terminal blocks to organize wiring. Avoid sharp bends and ensure cables are not in contact with hot surfaces. Label all cables clearly for maintenance and troubleshooting ().
