Purpose of Cable Tray Marking

Cable tray markings serve to identify the type of conductors, voltage levels, and potential hazards, ensuring safe installation, maintenance, and troubleshooting. Proper labeling reduces errors, enhances safety, and facilitates compliance with regulatory standards in industrial, commercial, and data center environments .

High-Voltage Warning Requirements

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) 392.18(H), cable trays containing conductors rated over 600 volts must display a permanent, legible warning notice stating: “DANGER — HIGH VOLTAGE — KEEP AWAY”. These labels must be placed in readily visible positions along the tray at intervals not exceeding 10 feet (3 meters). The labels must comply with NEC 110.21(B), which specifies effective wording, colors, symbols, and font requirements to adequately warn of hazards .

Commercially available markers, such as MS-478 Cable Tray Markers, are designed for smooth-sided trays and harsh environments. They are typically self-adhesive, chemical-resistant, and UV-protected, allowing labeling of junctions, branches, and trays leading to equipment.
