Shallow trays suit lightweight cables, while medium to deep trays accommodate larger power or fiber optic bundles . **Length:** Standard straight sections simplify installation and structural design, typically ranging from 2 to 3 meters per section, depending on manufacturer specifications .

Cross-Sectional Area and Fill Calculation

The usable cross-sectional area of a tray is calculated as: $\text{Usable Area} = \text{Inside Width} \times \text{Usable Depth}$ Cable fill is determined by the total cross-sectional area of all cables to be installed. Electrical codes, such as the NEC, limit tray fill to a percentage of the usable area:

- Power and lighting circuits: Maximum 50% fill for single-layer installations to allow...
