

# Cable tray expansion joint



## AI Overview

Cable tray expansion joints are installed to accommodate thermal expansion and contraction, preventing structural stress and maintaining system integrity.

### Purpose of Expansion Joints

Cable trays, typically made of metal such as steel or aluminum, expand and contract with temperature changes. Without proper expansion joints, these movements can cause bending, misalignment, bolt elongation, or even detachment from supports, especially in outdoor or high-temperature environments . Expansion joints absorb these movements, allowing the tray to slide or expand without damaging the cables or tray structure .

### Standards and Guidelines

- NEC Section 300-7(b) requires raceways, including cable trays, to have expansion joints where necessary to compensate for thermal expansion or contraction .
- NEMA VE 1 provides detailed recommendations for metallic cable tray systems, including allowable lengths between expansion joints based on material and temperature differential. For example, a steel tray may require an expansion joint every 128 feet for a 100°F temperature change, while aluminum may require one every 65 feet .
- Expansion joints should be installed near structural expansion points but also consider the tray's own thermal movement, as tray and structure materials expand differently ....
