Proper cable tray spacing ensures safety, accessibility, heat dissipation, and minimizes electromagnetic interference in computer rooms.

Horizontal and Vertical Spacing

- Parallel trays: When installing two cable trays at the same height, maintain a minimum horizontal distance of 0.6 meters to allow maintenance access, inspection, and proper airflow for heat dissipation .
- Power vs. signal trays: Keep a minimum separation of 0.5 meters between power and signal cable trays to reduce electromagnetic interference (EMI). If trays are shielded, this distance can be reduced to 0.3 meters .
- Vertical spacing: For floor-mounted trays, maintain at least 150 millimeters of vertical clearance to prevent obstruction, allow future expansion, and facilitate ventilation .

Support Spacing

- General support intervals: Cable trays should be supported at regular intervals according to the National Electrical Code (NEC), typically no more than 1.2 meters (4 feet) between supports .
- Ladder trays: For heavy-duty or large power cables, supports should be placed to prevent sagging and maintain structural integrity. Rung spacing depends on cable type: 6–12 inches for small control cables and 9 inches or wider for large power cab...
