Cable tray support spans typically range from 1.5 meters to 3 meters, depending on tray type, cable weight, and installation method.

Typical Span Ranges

For horizontal straight runs, the distance between supports is generally 1.5 to 3 meters to allow for proper maintenance access and prevent sagging . In some cases, lighter cables or specially designed trays can span up to 6 to 24 feet (approximately 1.8 to 7.3 meters) without additional support, but this depends on the tray type and load . Outdoor or long-span installations, such as crossing roads, may require spans of 20 to 40 feet, with careful consideration of splice plate placement and tray strength .

Factors Affecting Span

- **Cable Weight:** Heavier cables require shorter spans to avoid excessive deflection or mechanical strain .
- **Tray Type:** Ladder trays, ventilated troughs, and solid-bottom trays have different load capacities; solid-bottom trays can generally support longer spans .
- **Installation Method:** Ceiling-mounted trapeze hangers, cantilever wall brackets, or direct wall supports influence the maximum span .
- **Code Compliance:** Local building codes and standards such as NEC 392.22, NEMA VE-1/VE-2, and BS 7671 require that trays are supported to prevent undue mechanical strain and ensure fire safety
