Overview

Cables rated 600 volts or less can be installed together in the same cable tray without additional separation, provided they meet the NEC requirements for fill and support. This is a description of how to select, install, and support these metal or plastic frames, on which electrical wires are installed. The three main types of cable tray are: Perforated Cable Trays. When properly selected and installed, cable trays simplify routing, improve accessibility, and support future expansion while. Where installed in uncovered cable trays, ampacity of single-conductor PV wire smaller than 1/0 AWG, the adjustment factors for 1/0 AWG single conductor cable in 392. 80 (A) (2) shall be permitted to be used. Where single-conductor PV wire smaller than 1/0 AWG is installed in ladder or ventilated.
