Overview

If water penetrates the insulation and reaches the wires, issues may arise. Corrosion of metal conductors could cause arcing (sparks) or short circuits. Finding water in an electrical box is hazardous and demands immediate attention. An electrical box refers to any enclosure housing wiring connections. The National Electrical Code (NEC) and similar local regulations provide a comprehensive framework for electrical installations in wet environments. What is considered a wet environment?

A wet environment is any space where there is a risk of contact. In addition to requirements for GFCI protection for personnel, wiring devices used in these areas must meet specific testing criteria to ensure the integrity of electrical connections in moisture-laden environments.
