Classification by Fiber Mode

Fiber optic patch cords are divided into single-mode and multimode types. Single-mode cables have a narrow core, allowing only one light path, which reduces attenuation and supports long-distance transmission, making them ideal for telecom and campus networks (yellow jacket) . Multimode cables have a wider core, supporting multiple light paths, higher bandwidth over short distances, and are commonly used in data centers and LANs. Multimode jackets are color-coded: OM1/OM2 (orange), OM3 (aqua), OM4 (violet), and OM5 (lime green) .

Classification by Connector Type

Patch cords are also classified by connector types, which ensure precise optical alignment. Common connectors include:

- LC: Small form factor, duplex, widely used in modern data centers .
- SC: Square snap-in connector, common in PON and enterprise networks .
- ST: Bayonet mount, legacy or industrial LANs .
- FC: Screw-on, suitable for high-vibration environments .
- MPO/MTP: Multi-fiber connectors for high-density parallel optics (8, 12, 24 fibers)
