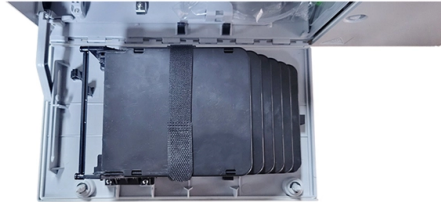


# Cold Joint Test



## Overview

Ultrasonic Pulse Velocity (UPV) is an effective non-destructive testing (NDT) method for quality control of concrete materials, and evaluating concrete integrity on or around the cold joint. Ultrasonic testing of concrete is an effective way for quality assessment and uniformity, and crack depth. A cold joint in concrete is an area or surface with a structural discontinuity caused by the delayed concrete pouring between two layers of concrete. The delayed placement prevents full integration and knitting between the concrete batches and might lead to reduced structural robustness, increased.
