- **Procurement and Factory Acceptance Testing (FAT)** Equipment such as IEDs, PLCs, sensors, and actuators are tested at the manufacturer's facility to verify compliance with specifications. FAT helps identify issues early, reducing delays during on-site commissioning .
- **Installation and Mechanical Completion** Devices are installed according to design specifications, including transformers, circuit breakers, CTs, PTs, and actuators. Mechanical completion involves verifying that all components are correctly installed and ready for pre-commissioning checks .
- **Pre-Commissioning** This stage includes individual device testing, network connectivity checks, and functional verification. For distribution automation, this may involve validating Device Level Ring (DLR) networks for redundancy, checking sens...
