This approach allows calls and messages to be sent over distances of up to 7 kilometers under ideal conditions, though urban environments may reduce this range due to obstacles and interference .

This creates a chain of communication that can extend coverage far beyond the direct range of a single device, potentially enabling connectivity in remote or disaster-affected areas without any telecom infrastructure .
