

Company Distribution Box Grounding Requirements Standards



Overview

148 (Grounding Conductor): Requires metallic junction boxes—and by extension, cabinet doors—to bond to ground using a designated grounding screw or clip. If you're working with electrical systems, you know that grounding isn't just some bureaucratic requirement—it's literally the difference between a safe, functional system and a potential disaster. Today, we're diving deep into the world of distribution box grounding, breaking down the standards. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. IN ELECTRICAL STATIONS INCLUDING TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION SUBSTATION GR THAN 8 FT FROM THE FENCE. THE FENCE SHALL BE GROUNDED SEPARATELY FROM THE GRID UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED ON THE A PROPRIATE PROJECT DRAWING. The 2026 NEC reorganizes Article 250 to focus on systems operating at 1,000 volts AC or less (or 1,500 volts).
