Inspect under a microscope or splicer camera to ensure no dust, oil, or residue remains . **Inserting Protective Sleeves:** Before splicing, slide a heat-shrink splice sleeve onto one fiber end. This sleeve cannot be added after fusion, so proper placement is critical .

2. Fiber Cleaving

Use a precision cleaver to create a flat, perpendicular end face (95% of fiber tensile strength) and optical performance.
