Physical and Logical Connections

To connect to a core switch effectively:

- **Interconnect Distribution Switches:** Core switches link multiple distribution switches, reducing the number of direct connections required between them and providing a central point for traffic aggregation .
- **Redundancy:** Use multiple links or port channels between the core and distribution switches to prevent isolation if a single link fails .
- **Trunking:** Configure trunk ports to carry multiple VLANs between the core and distribution switches. Ensure the trunk encapsulation is correctly set (e.g., dot1q) and the port mode is trunk
