4. Splice the Fiber to Pigtails Use either fusion or mechanical splicing to connect the incoming fiber to pre-installed pigtails inside the terminal box . Place the spliced fibers neatly in the splice tray to protect them and prevent tangling.
5. Organize and Store Excess Fiber Wind any extra fiber in the storage area of the box, ensuring it follows the proper bend radius and does not overlap or stress the fibers . Position adapters in the panel slots if required.
6. Close and Label the Box After all fibers are spliced and organized, close the box lid tightly to prevent dust and moisture ingress . Label each port clearly for easy identification during troubleshooting or future maint...
