As we know it is impractical to connect multiple conductors at one point. Hence we use bus bars, where these connections can be done spaciouly and. I came to conclusion that bypass arrangement exists in main and transfer bus systems so that supply from line side can be transferred to feeder side. As shown in the diagram, sectionalized bus bar ends are connected with another bus bar, with bus couplers to form a closed loop. Hence called as ring main bus system.
