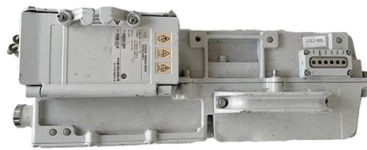


Diagram of fiber optic cable connection method
