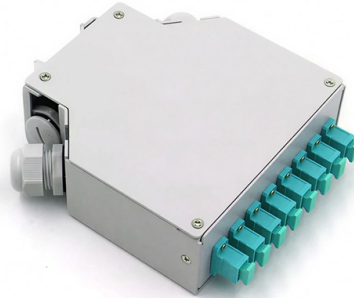


Distance between electrical cable tray supports

The typical support distance for cable trays ranges from 1.5 to 3 meters for horizontal runs, with vertical supports preferably less than 2 meters, depending on tray type and load.

Horizontal Support Spacing

For straight horizontal runs, the distance between supports (brackets or hangers) generally ranges from 1.5 meters to 3 meters. Ladder-type trays, perforated trays, and wire mesh trays all follow this guideline, though the exact spacing should consider the weight of cables, environmental loads, and manufacturer specifications. The NEC specifies that supports should not exceed 5 feet (approximately 1.5 meters) for horizontal runs, with an ideal range of 4 to 6 feet (1.2-1.8 meters) for ladder trays to ensure uniform load distribution and prevent sagging .

Vertical Support Spacing

For vertical cable tray runs, supports should be fixed to the building structure with a spacing preferably less than 2 meters. This ensures stability and prevents undue stress on the tray and cables .
