Optical modules typically have an electrical interface on the side that connects to the inside of the system and an optical interface on the side that connects to the outside world through a fiber optic cable. An optical module is a typically hot-pluggable optical transceiver used in high-bandwidth data communications applications. Whether in 5G base stations, hyperscale data centers, or long-haul telecom networks, these modules convert electrical signals into optical ones — and back again — to ensure fast, stable, and. The optics module is comprised of Si photodiodes, optical components, and current-to-voltage conversion circuit.
