Yes, all metallic cable tray supports must be grounded to ensure electrical safety and compliance with NEC standards.

NEC Requirements

According to the National Electrical Code (NEC) Article 250.96 and Article 392, all metallic cable trays must be grounded, regardless of whether the tray itself is used as an equipment grounding conductor (EGC) or not . Grounding provides a safe path for fault currents, reducing the risk of electric shock, fire, or equipment damage .

Methods of Grounding

- **Separate Grounding Conductor:** A dedicated EGC (minimum size #4 AWG) can be installed inside or attached to the tray to bond all sections together .
- **Cable Tray as EGC:** In qualifying installations, the tray itself can serve as the EGC if it meets minimum cross-sectional area requirements for steel or aluminum trays . Steel trays are limited to circuits with ground-fault protection up to 600 amperes, while aluminum trays can handle up to 2,000 amperes .
- **Bonding Clamps and Jumpers:** Grounding clamps or bonding jumpers are used at tray joints, splices, and where the tray connects to equipment to ensure electrical continuity .
