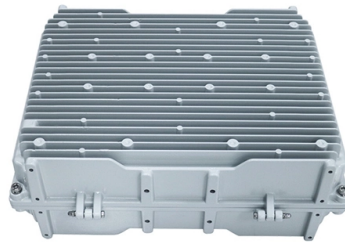


Dual-optical module connection



AI Overview

Dual-optical modules use two separate fibers—one for transmitting (TX) and one for receiving (RX)—and require proper polarity alignment to ensure correct data flow.

Overview of Dual-Fiber Modules

Dual-fiber optical transceivers are widely used in networks and employ two fiber strands: one dedicated to transmitting data (TX) and the other to receiving data (RX) (). Each fiber carries the same wavelength, and the transceiver converts electrical signals into optical signals for transmission and vice versa for reception. This setup provides full-duplex communication and is easier to configure than single-fiber bidirectional modules ().

Connection Method

- Identify TX and RX Ports: Each dual-fiber module has clearly labeled TX and RX ports. The TX port of one device must connect to the RX port of the other device, and vice versa ().
- Use Duplex Connectors: Common connectors include LC-Duplex or SC-Duplex, which bundle the two fibers together for easier handling ().
- Maintain Polarity: Correct polarity ensures signals are received at the intended port. Standard methods include:
 - A-B (Crossover) Polarity: TX on one end connects to RX on the other end; this is the most common configuration.
 - A-A (Straight-Through) Polarity: TX connects to TX and RX to RX; less common and used in specific setups ()....
