Overview

Fibre-optic Link Around the Globe (FLAG) is a 28,000-kilometre-long (17,398 mi; 15,119 nmi) fibre optic mostly- submarine communications cable that connects the United Kingdom, Japan, India, and many places in between. The Asia-Pacific fiber optics market is experiencing a surge in growth, driven by the adoption of cutting-edge technologies like Wavelength Division Multiplexing (WDM) and Dense Wavelength Division Multiplexing (DWDM). These technologies enhance data capacity by transmitting multiple light. The East Asia To North America (E2A) cable system is a 12500km submarine cable connecting major digital hubs in Asia and North America, with landings in Toucheng (Taiwan), Busan (South Korea), Hokaiido, Maruyama and Fukuoka (Japan), and Morro Bay (California, USA). The E2A cable system features: 12. Asia Pacific Cable Network-2 (APCN-2) was jointly initiated by 26 investment institutions to connect Asian countries and regions, with a total length of about 19,000 km and a total of 10 landing stations, including Shanghai Chongming and Guangdong Shantou, New Taipei City, Taiwan, China; Lantau. Trans Pacific Networks is part of the Echo undersea telecommunication network connecting the United States to Indonesia and Singapore, which avoids political hot spots.
