Traction systems often incorporate winches, pulleys, and specialized drum mechanisms to control cable movement. Advanced designs, such as fan-shaped connect rod mechanisms and U-shaped groove fixed pulley groups, allow multi-directional traction without derailment and reduce mechanical wear. Dynamic models, including Euler transformations and Kalman filter-based tension planning, are used to manage inertia delays and emergency stops, particularly in unmanned electro-optical systems. These systems ensure that the cable maintains proper tension while supporting variable loads and directions....
