Installing a distribution box under or within stairs is generally discouraged due to safety and code restrictions, though it may be possible in non-egress areas with proper clearance and compliance.

Key Considerations

Code Compliance: Electrical panels or distribution boxes cannot be installed in stairways or exit paths that serve as a means of egress. According to NEC and local building codes, stairwells are considered exit enclosures, and only equipment serving the stairway itself (like lighting or pressurization systems) is permitted in these areas . Installing a panel in a stairway could violate fire safety codes and compromise the stairway's fire rating . **Clearance Requirements:** If a panel is placed under stairs in a non-egress area, it must still meet minimum working space requirements. NEC 110.26 specifies a minimum headroom of 6.5 feet and a clear working space of 30 inches wide by 36 inches deep in front of the panel . Panels cannot be installed directly over stair treads or in locations that obstruct access. **Accessibility:** The panel must remain easily accessible for maintenance and emergency shutoff. Recessed or flush-mounted panels may reduce visibility but cannot compromise access or violate clearance rules . **Avoid placing panels where someone could be bumped into live components when opening the door.** **Safety and Materials:** Choose a distribution box suitable for the environment, considering indoor/outdoor use, load capacity, and durability. Steel or plastic enclosures are common, with proper grounding, insulation, and breaker sizing . Ensure the box is installed on a stable surface and that wiring is neat and compliant with NEC or local codes. **Alternatives:** If hiding the panel is desired, consider placing it behind a door in a hallway or closet adjacent to the stair...
