Purpose of Grounding Cable Trays

Grounding a cable tray provides a safe path for stray electrical currents to flow into the earth, protecting personnel and equipment from electric shocks, fires, or equipment damage. It ensures that any fault current is quickly diverted, maintaining system stability and safety (Apex Tray Guide), .

NEC Requirements

- Article 392 of the National Electrical Code (NEC) governs cable tray grounding and bonding. All metallic trays must be electrically continuous and properly bonded at splice points (ShowMeCables), .
- Cable trays can serve as the Equipment Grounding Conductor (EGC) if they meet minimum metal cross-sectional area requirements and are installed according to NEC Table 392.60(A) (IDC Online), .
- Steel trays should not be used as EGCs for circuits with ground-fault protection above 600 A, and aluminum trays above 2000 A (IDC Online), .
