Overview

As charge builds up, the voltage increases and may break down the insulating properties of the surrounding air – an electrostatic discharge (ESD) can occur that could ignite a flammable atmosphere. An unearthed conductor also poses a hidden risk. What is static electricity?

Static electricity refers to the presence of a non-neutral electric charge on an object. It is the only hazard on our site that can destroy a €400 control board at 20 volts and kill three operators at 25 millijoules. Most workplaces treat those as separate problems, managed by different departments — electronics. It can cause damage to sensitive electronic components, raise the electromagnetic interference (EMI) or radio frequency interference (RFI) noise floor, and, in extreme cases, lead to fires and explosions.
