AI Overview

Proper grounding of distribution boxes ensures safety, prevents equipment damage, and maintains low-resistance fault paths, typically targeting less than 0.1 ohm.

Key Principles

Grounding provides a low-impedance path for fault currents, ensuring that exposed metallic parts of distribution boxes do not carry dangerous voltages and that protective devices operate effectively during faults. It also helps divert transient surges, such as lightning, safely to earth.

Conductor Sizing and Connections

- Grounding conductors should be sized equal to or larger than phase conductors to reduce impedance and improve fault clearing times.
- For distribution boxes, typical grounding wire sizes are 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) in the US and 6 mm² in other markets.
- Ground wires should connect the distribution box housing to the mounting plate, and from the mounting plate to the central grounding point.
- For systems with multiple spindles or long tool cables, additional parallel grounding wires may be required to maintain total resistance below safe limits.
