Power Supply: Relays require an external DC or AC power source, typically 24V, 48V, or 110V DC for industrial relays, or 12V for smaller control circuits. Ensure the supply matches the relay's rated voltage and polarity requirements .

Input and Control Signals: The relay receives input signals from current transformers (CTs), voltage transformers (VTs), or sensors. These inputs trigger the relay to operate under fault conditions. Modern Intelligent Electronic Devices (IEDs) follow IEC 61850 standards for signal processing and communication .

Output Contacts: Relays control circuit breakers or other devices through their output contacts. The common (COM) pin connects to the load or breaker trip coil, while normally open (NO) or normally closed (NC) contacts determine the switching behavior . For medium- and high-voltage breakers, the relay output triggers the breaker remotely rather than relying on internal sensing .

Protective Components: Flyback diodes are often used across relay coils to prevent voltage spikes when the coil is de-energized. Base resistors are used when driving relays via transistors to limit current and protect control electronics .

Isolation: Maintain electrical isolation between low-voltage control circuits and high-voltage power circuits. This prevents accidental shocks and ensures reliable operation .
