- Overhead installations require minimum clearances: at least 18 feet above traveled roads and 40 inches from energized conductors. Utility pole attachment heights and midspan clearances must follow construction drawings .
- Underground installations must avoid sharp edges in ducts, manholes, or handholes to prevent pinching or crushing . 4. Temperature and Environmental Considerations Cables should be installed within the specified temperature range for both storage and installation. LSZH sheathed cables are more sensitive to mechanical stress, an...
