Entry and Securing of the Cable

When a fiber optic cable reaches the terminal box, it is first inserted through an entry port or grommet designed to protect the fibers from mechanical stress and environmental damage . The cable is then fixed in place using clamps or brackets inside the box, providing strain relief to prevent tension from being transmitted to the delicate fiber cores . This ensures that pulling or bending outside the box does not damage the fibers.

Fiber Termination and Splicing

Once the cable is secured, the individual fiber cores are exposed and prepared for termination. Each core is typically spliced to a fiber pigtail using fusion splicing inside the terminal box . The pigtails are then connected to adapters or couplers that provide standardized ports (commonly SC/APC in FTTH networks) for patch cords to connect to ONTs or other devices . The terminal box may include splice trays or cassettes to organize and protect the spliced fibers, as well as to store any excess fiber slack safely .
