

# Fiber optic cable junction temperature

The silica glass core itself is highly stable, with a very low thermal expansion coefficient ( $\sim 0.5 \times 10^{-6}/^{\circ}\text{C}$ ), but the surrounding polymer coatings, buffer tubes, and jackets expand or contract much more with temperature changes, creating mechanical stress at junctions or splices. Exceeding these limits can lead to microbending or macrobending, increasing signal attenuation and potentially causing permanent signal loss.

### High-Temperature Effects

At temperatures above  $+80^{\circ}\text{C}$ , polymer coatings may soften, oxidize, or peel, reducing their protective function and exposing the fiber core to mechanical stress. In extreme cases, such as exposure above  $+120^{\circ}\text{C}$ , the core may deform permanently. Specialized high-temperature fibers with stainless steel jackets or polyimide coatings can withstand higher temperatures, sometimes exceeding  $+200^{\circ}\text{C}$ , but these are used in industrial or harsh environments.
