Understanding the Impact of Scratches

Scratches on a fiber optic cable can cause signal loss, increased attenuation, or complete failure if they affect the core where light travels . Minor scratches in the cladding or outer zones may be tolerable, but any imperfection in the core zone is critical and can significantly degrade performance . Even small scratches can scatter light, reducing optical efficiency and potentially causing intermittent connectivity issues .

Inspection and Identification

To assess scratches, use a fiber inspection microscope to examine the end face of the connector . The IEC 61300-3-35 standard provides guidelines for classifying scratches and defects in four zones: core (Zone A), cladding (Zone B), adhesive (Zone C), and ferrule/contact (Zone D). For single-mode fibers, any scratch in the core is unacceptable, while multimode fibers may tolerate very small scratches under strict limits . Automated inspection tools can provide PASS/FAIL grading based on these standards, reducing human error .
