Purpose of Test Point A

Common Testing Methods

- **Visible Light Source (VFL)** A visible light source can be connected at Test Point A to check for continuity. If light is visible at the opposite end, the fiber is intact. This method is useful for quickly locating breaks or faults along the cable .
- **Power Meter and Light Source** Often called the one-jumper method, this involves connecting a calibrated light source at Test Point A and measuring the received power at the far end. This method accurately determines end-to-end signal loss and verifies that the fiber meets insertion loss specifications .
- **Optical Time Domain Reflectometer (OTDR)** An OTDR can be connected at Test Point A to analyze the entire fiber link, including splices and connectors. It provides a detailed trace showing the location of faults, reflections, and attenuation along the fiber, which is especially useful for long or outside plant cables
