Overview

Fiber optic cables transmit data using pulses of light, making them entirely immune to electromagnetic interference. When power and communications cables intersect, the code specifies that they should cross perpendicularly, at a 90-degree angle. Excessive bending—especially at small radii—can lead to signal attenuation or loss, known as macrobending. Separation isn't just an EMI precaution — it protects signaling, reduces rework, and ensures pathways meet inspection expectations across risers.
