Role of Routers and Switches

Routers and switches are active networking devices that manage data traffic and assign IP addresses, but they cannot physically split a fiber optic signal. For Ethernet over fiber, a switch or router is required to distribute the network traffic to multiple devices while maintaining proper bandwidth allocation . Simply connecting multiple routers to a single fiber line without a switch or splitter will not work, as the fiber connection cannot be shared directly among multiple devices .
