

# Fiber optic pigtail and coupler testing



## Overview

For visual testing, simply use a high-power visible laser visual fault locator (VFL) with a pigtail and mechanical splice as shown above for loss testing. As with any splice, a good fiber cleave is needed to ensure good fiber coupling. Testing a splitter or other passive fiber optic devices like switches is little different from testing a patchcord or cable plant using the two industry standard tests, OFSTP-14 for double-ended loss (connectors on both ends) or FOTP-171 for single-ended testing.
