 - Compatible with single-mode fiber for long distances or multi-mode fiber for shorter distances.
 - Typically use LC-type connectors for fiber connections.
- SFP+ Ports
 - Enhanced version of SFP, supporting 10G speeds.
 - Often used for uplinks to core switches or high-performance servers
