

Fiber optic switch wattage



Overview

This article helps network engineers, field technicians, and facilities teams quantify transceiver wattage for SFP, SFP+, and QSFP-class fiber optics, then translate it into energy efficiency and operating cost. The 2003 PoE standard 802.3af provided a meager 15 watts of power. This allowed some smaller devices to benefit from a single hybrid network/ power cable connection via the common RJ45 plug. Unfortunately, this standard enabled only basic devices such as VoIP phones and IP cameras; all other.
