Fibre Channel (FC) is a high-speed network protocol designed specifically for connecting servers to storage devices in Storage Area Networks (SANs). It provides lossless, in-order delivery of block data and supports data rates from 1 Gbps up to 128 Gbps, depending on the technology generation . Unlike general-purpose networks like Ethernet, Fibre Channel is optimized for predictable performance, low latency, and high reliability, making it ideal for enterprise storage environments .

How Fibre Channel Works

Fibre Channel networks use optical fiber or copper cabling to connect devices through a switched fabric topology, where switches route data between servers and storage devices efficiently . Each device in the network is a node with one or more ports:...
