

Grounding of electrical equipment distribution boxes

Purpose of Grounding

Grounding is essential to protect both people and electrical equipment under normal and fault conditions. It stabilizes voltages during transient events, dissipates energy from lightning strikes, and ensures correct operation of electrical devices. A well-grounded system provides a safe path for fault currents while maintaining voltage stability and minimizing the risk of electrical shock or fire .

Grounding Requirements for Distribution Boxes

- **Connection to Ground:** Each distribution box and controller must be connected to a reliable grounding system. This typically involves attaching a ground wire from a threaded stud on the box to a mounting plate, and then from the mounting plate to a central grounding point .
- **Wire Sizing:** Ground wire size depends on regional standards. In the US, a 10 AWG (5.26 mm²) wire is commonly used, while other markets may require a 6 mm² wire. For connections between mounting plates and spindles, larger wires (e.g., 6 AWG or 16 mm²) may be necessary to maintain low resistance .
- **Resistance Limits:** The total ground resistance between all system parts should be less than 0.1 ohm for industrial applications. For general distribution box installations, a maximum of 25 ohms is recommended, with multiple rods or parallel connections...
