

Height Limit for Cable Trays

Cable trays must have at least 12 inches of clear vertical space above them for installation and maintenance, with support spacing and height determined by manufacturer specifications and load requirements.

Vertical Clearance

Support Spacing and Height Considerations

The maximum height of a cable tray system is influenced by the span between supports and the type of tray used:

- Standard trays typically require supports every 6 to 10 feet.
- Heavy-duty or long-span trays can handle supports up to 20 feet apart .
- Extra-long spans may exceed 20 feet, especially for outdoor installations crossing roads or open areas . The tray height and material thickness also affect load capacity. Taller side rails and thicker materials allow trays to support heavier cables at greater heights without excessive deflection . Ladder trays, for example, are designed for heavy cable loads and long spans, with rung spacing and side rail height optimized for structural strength
