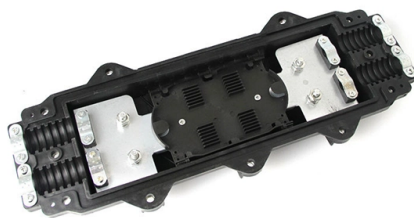

High-voltage and low-voltage cables should not share a cable tray unless proper separation, shielding, or barriers are implemented to comply with safety standards and prevent interference.

Safety and Regulatory Considerations

Running HV and LV cables in the same tray can create electrical hazards and signal interference. High-voltage cables generate magnetic fields that can induce unwanted currents in nearby low-voltage circuits, potentially causing data corruption, equipment malfunction, or voltage hazards. Overheating from improper grouping can also increase fire risks. The National Electrical Code (NEC) and IEC 60364-5-52 provide clear guidance on separation to mitigate these risks .

NEC Requirements

- NEC Article 300.3(C) prohibits mixing power and low-voltage cables in the same raceway or tray unless specific separation or shielding is applied .
- NEC Article 392.20(B) allows HV ($>600V$) and LV ($\leq 600V$) cables to share a tray only if:
 - HV cables are Type MC, or
 - A fixed solid barrier compatible with the tray material is installed to separate the voltage classes .
- Minimum separation distances are typically 2 inches (50 mm) for parallel runs, wh...
