Electrical Interface

Optical Interface

The optical interface connects the module to the outside world via fiber optic cables, either single-mode or multi-mode. This connection is made using fiber optic connectors such as LC, SC, MPO, or MTP, depending on the module form factor and application . The transmitter optical subassembly (TOSA) emits light into the fiber, while the receiver optical subassembly (ROSA) converts incoming light back into electrical signals . The optical interface ensures low-loss, high-speed data transmission over the fiber network.
