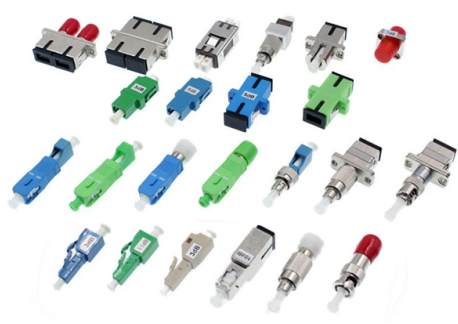

Overview of Splicing Methods

- **Fusion Splicing:** Typically takes longer due to precise fiber preparation, core alignment, and the fusion process itself. While highly reliable and low-loss, it is slower than mechanical splicing, especially in field conditions
