Use elbows or radius control fittings to maintain smooth transitions . **Spacing and Load Considerations:** Avoid overcrowding at exit points. Distribute cables evenly and ensure that the tray and supports are rated for the total cable load. Overloaded trays can sag or stress cables, leading to mechanical failure
